Required to continue in Dr. Schramm's practice:

2 month DTaP, Hib, PCV must be given between 2-4 months old.

4 month DTaP #2, Hib #2, PCV #2 must be given between 4-6 months old.

6 month DtaP #3, Hib #3, PCV #3 must be given between 6-8 months old.

12 month MMR & Varicella must be given between 12-15 months old.

15 month Hib #4 & PCV #4 must be given between 15-18 months old.

18 month DTaP #4 must be given between 18-21 months old.

Hepatitis B & Polio vaccines are required for daycare & preschool entry.

Pre-K DTaP #5, MMR #2, and Varicella #2 must be given between 4-6 years old.

Tdap is required for 7th grade school entry.
